## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the writer draws the conclusion that the students' existing method that was inappropriate with their program since the method can increase their ability in teaching learning process. They found it difficult to say something in the class and to communicate with each other than to do the exercise. To answer the problems of study, there were two points bellow:
