# CHAPTER 1

# INTRODUCTION

## A. The Background of the Study

English, as an international language plays a great contribution in human life. It is one tool that supports people to know this world. There are four skills that should be achieved in learning English, namely: Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. Reading is one of the most difficult language skills in learning language. In reading, the students are expected to be knowledge able and familiar with what the teacher has explained in the context; where as in comprehension the students are expected to have more skills than to explain individual text or passage after comprehending them.

In fact, many students think that reading is a difficult skill. Based on the researcher did observations to students in SMP SWASTA BANDUNG, students' achievement in reading is still very low. Most of the students can't reading a text. Its caused they don't own idea, so that they face problem in building a text. And also they lack of vocabularies, so that they can't choose the right words, and using the grammar in organizing the text. Teacher also only gives the topic to the students and then explains it and asks them to answer the questions based on the text. Without use media in learning process.

There are some factors which influence the students' difficulties in reading comprehension. First, the students have a language problem. The students can understand the text if they understand the language. Second, the foundational skills of reading such as reception, decoding, and learning have not been mastered by students, they will get difficulties in reading such as reading haltingly. At last, the students are unable to decode the written words. The decoding of the written words is a very important aspect of the reading act. Without being able to decode the written word, reading comprehension is impossible. In order to make teaching and learning process interesting and effective, teachers need good techniques. They will help the students to learn faster and to remember information for a long period of time. For this purpose, the researcher proposes a technique named comic strips is defined in this study as series of pictures inside boxes that tell a story.

The writer found the same problem with students in SMP SWASTA BANDUNG. The problems are students still feel strange and face some difficulties with English lesson, especially in developing reading comprehension. The problem face in the class is sometimes the students have difficulties to find out the main of a sentence in a text. The Minimal Completeness Criteria (KKM) applied for the eighth grade (VIII) by school is 75. Most students get the score under Minimal Completeness Criteria (KKM) of English lesson for Junior High School. The score of reading test from the students can be seen in table 1.1
