## ABSTRACT

Since English is an international language, government decides it as one of the compulsory subject taught in any level of education. Therefore, in higher education it is taught not only for English department students but also for those who are majoring in Informatics Management and Computer Academy. However, English which is taught in this major is not General English anymore. English is taught for them in order they can use it to support their studying in their major. English for Specific Purposes (ESP) is the suitable and important course to be applied to teach those students. ESP course is designed to meet the needs of learners in studying English.
