

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusions

The conclusion of this research is drawn based on the data analysis, findings and discussion as the following.

1. Theme and Rheme Structure in Barack Obama's Speech on General Election Campaign dominated by Unmarked Multiple Theme (UMT). The percentage is (50 %), whereas Theme and Rheme Structure in Barack Obama's Speech on Presidential Inauguration of 2009 dominated by Unmarked Simple Theme (UST). The percentage is (48.4 %).
2. Patterns of Thematic Development in Barack Obama's Speech on General Election Campaign dominated by Constant Theme Pattern (CTP). The percentage is (94.2 %). Meanwhile, the pattern of Thematic Development in Barack Obama's Speech on Presidential Inauguration of 2009 is also dominated by Constant Theme Pattern (CTP). The percentage is (92.5%).
3. The structures of Theme and Rheme used in Barack Obama's Speech on General Election Campaign dominated by Given-New information. The percentage is (96.7%). Whereas, the structure of Theme and Rheme used in Barack Obama's Speech on Presidential Inauguration of 2009 also dominated by Given-New information. The percentage is (90.8 %).

5.2 Suggestions

After analyzing Barack Obama's Speech on general election campaign and presidential election of 2009 considering with Theme and Rheme structures, the following suggestions are addressed.

1. This study will be relevant used by the learners to improve their ability to understand and produce texts which are effective in conveying meaning.
2. Lecturers should be able to teach their learners in using theme and rheme in speech in order to make the learners become mastery in analyzing the theme and rheme in any Speech.
3. By having a specific study, also this study will be exploration of more detailed analysis of Theme and Rheme Structures and the pattern of language development in Speech specifically, and discourse generally. From linguistic perspective, this will help in strengthening the significance of this analysis to provide a critical tool for analysis of discourse in general.
4. To other researchers are advised to explore analysis of thematic structure and development in Speech text more detailed. This will help in strengthening the significance of this kind analysis which is to provide a critical tool for the analysis of text of Speech from linguistic perspective.

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
