CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the analysis of 99 data in the form of clauses in Ahok's speech, it was obtained several conclusions as the following:

- 1) The writer found three kinds of attitudinal appraisal in Ahok's speech. It means that all the attitudinal appraisal types which are affect, judgment and appreciation and three types are included positive and negative that found in each types. The dominant type of attitudinal appraisal in Ahok's speech was Affect and specifically positive affect found in Ahok's speech because in Ahok's speech contained his inclination and willingness in his program to advance Kepulauan Seribu.
- 2) The writer found that words, phrases and clauses are the realization of attitudinal appraisal and the most dominants was word, because in Ahok's speech, attitudes were associated by word directly. There was not found sound for realizing attitudinal appraisal in Ahok's speech and it was found that the using of metaphor and analogy to compare two different behavior. In this research, derivational repetition found as new finding in realizing attitudinal appraisal.
- 3) The contexts of attitudinal appraisal used in Ahok's speech namely tenor and context of situation that showed by tenor were formal/unequal/positive affect/infrequent where in Ahok's speech described meeting in Kepulauan Seribu was formal situation where in that meeting he discussed about

cultivation. Status in this speech was unequal where it might be made addressee believe what he said with showed his positive feeling in terms of contact in which infrequent interaction, he tended to persuade local people in Kepulauan Seribu to join in his program in cultivation field.

5.2 suggestions

In relation to conclusion, suggestions are staged as the following:

- a. For further studies should be conducted to find out more kinds of subsystem attitudinal appraisal in other context.
- b. For further studies should be conducted study to find out more the process of realized in the same context by providing more data to enrich the analysis of attitudinal appraisal in speech.
- c. For readers especially other researcher to understand the meaning appraisal deeply.
