

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The study was concerned with appraisal attitude by the judges aimed at describing the types, the attitude level and the reason of language attitude occurrences of judges in commenting the contestant, the conclusion was drawn as the following:

1. There were three types of appraisal attitude used by the judges of Indonesian idol in grand final session in giving the comments to the contestant, they are affect, judgement and appreciation. The judges tend to used the appreciation attitude in giving their comments to the contestant.
2. The level of language attitude used by the judges of Indonesian idol in grand final session in giving the comments to the contestant in this study found four level, they are responding, valuing, organizing and internalizing values. And the judges tend to use valuing level in their language attitude.
3. There were three reasons of language attitude occurrences used by the judges in commenting the contestant. They were in cognitive element, effective element and behaviour element. The reason of the judges used language attitude in cognitive element to set of factors and rational arguments that contribute to one's relation towards an object—that is, the

elements of one's attitude that are based on what one knows. The judges used affective element, on the other hand relates not to the rational but to the emotional components of one's relation towards an object and behavioral element of attitude also used by the judges to the way one tends to actually behave towards an object.

5.2 Suggestions

In relation to the conclusions, some constructive points are suggested as the following:

1. For the students when communicate to others or telling to other should realize that appraisal attitude intentionally need to use carefully so that consider and think what the words will be spoken out in the communication.
2. For the teachers, who want to know and learn about appraisal attitude study, this study can give the adding knowledge and references to improve and increase our view about appraisal attitudes of language.
3. To add the references for other researchers who interesting to make a research about appraisal attitudes, the findings of this study can add the references.
