CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The goal of this study is to examine the feminism in order to find out what type of feminism and the principles of feminism in Erin Brockovich based on the major characters. There are ten types of feminism according to Tong's theory, they are: Liberal feminism, Radical feminism, Marxism and Socialist feminism, Women on color feminism in united states, Women of color feminism on world stage, Psychoanalytic feminism, Care focused feminism, Ecofeminism, Existentialist, Post structural and Postmodern feminism, Third-Wave and Queer feminism.
