CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of The Study

Literature is a canon which consists of those works in language by which a community defines itself through the course of its history. It includes works primarily artistic and also those whose aesthetic qualities are only secondary. The self-defining activity of the community is conducted in the light of the works, as its members have come to read them (McFadden 1978:56). Based on David, literature is an art form, like painting, sculpture, music, drama, and the dance. Literature is distinguished from other arts form by the medium in which it works language (David, 1971:139). In other words, literature is the art of written or it can be assumed that literatureas a creative art that uses humans and all kinds of aspects of life can be used as a medium to convey ideas, theories, or systems of human thinking.

The development of literature in Indonesia is currently quite rapid. That was evident from many literary works that appeared, both in the form of poetry, short stories, prose and drama. All of the literary work is created by the author (the creator). The author itself in producing a literary work is a considerable form of progress in the development of the world of literature in Indonesia. Moody (1984: 5) said that literary works have four functions, they are:

- 3. to develop creation and feeling.
- 4. to support characterbuilding.

Literary works talks about human in many sides, bad and good. Through the reading activity, the readers will describe the characters in the story. Based on the four functions of literary work, it can develop human value; enrich experience through the life background of the characters in the story with various cultures, religions, races, and social status.

Literary criticism in feminist approach helps the writer look at literature in a different light. It applies the philosophies and perspectives of feminism to the literature. There are many different kinds of feminist literary theory. Some theorists examine the language and symbols that are used and how that language and use of symbols is "gendered." Others reminds that men and women write differently and analyze at how the gender of the author affects how literature is

written. Many feminist critics look at how the characters, especially the female characters, are portrayed and ask us to consider how the portrayal of female characters "reinforces or undermines sexual stereotypes" (Lynn: 2013).

Film, also called movie or motion picture, is a visual art used to simulate experiences that communicate ideas, stories, perceptions, feelings, beauty or atmosphere by the means of recorded or programmed moving images along with other sensory stimulations. The word "cinema", short for cinematography, is often used to refer to film making and the film industry, and to the art form that is the result of it. Film catches people attention through the visualization of the story and the sound effects. Film also can deliver the message to the viewer's more easily. Furthermore, people need less effort to watch a movie than to read a novel because they only need one or two hours to watch it. Film and literature are two different things with a similar goal to create sublimity in human imagination and understanding. Both film and literature work hand in hand to boost the progress of human civilization. They are the complimentary in nature and one is no substitute to the other, like letters and sounds in human communication. Film and literature inspire and enrich each other. Barnes goes on to define both the material and the technical. He defines the material as: "the simple visible features that form the whole essence and production of the literary text as well as the

visual text (film) in their unique form which becomes clearer to the reader and the viewer in form of contrast.

The film is a dramatization of the true story of ErinBrockovich, portrayed by Julia Roberts, who fought against the energy corporation Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E). The film was a box office success, and critical reaction was positive. Erin Brockovich is a single mother of three and a former Miss Wichita, defies expectations by convincing hundreds of families to sue the \$28 billion company Pacific Gas and Electric, who has poisoned the water supply of Hinkley, California with Hexavalent Chromium, and she succeeds to win the largest settlement ever pays in a direct action lawsuit, she fights against the American West Coast Energy Giant Pacific Gas and Electric Company is known as PG&E. Erin Brockovich film tells about a woman who have three children, and she must take care of her young children even though she works in the lawsuit office. She has no high education, no skill, but she has a spirit and hope she struggles to make her lifebetter.

There are several reasons why the researcher is interested in analyzes the film, including (1) the film is based on the true story, (2) the film which was starred Julia Robert succeeded as the winner of some categories such as Academy Awards, Golden Globe, Screen Actors Guild Award and BAFTA for category as the Best Actress and other nominations, (3) the film tells about a single mother with three children who fight for her life and her children to get the better life, (4)
