

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSSIONS AND SUGGESSTIONS

The study concerned on the attitudes of university students of Batubara in Medan towards Batubara malay language. After deliberatly analyzing the data, the conslusions are stated as follows:

5.1 Conclusion

1. The university students of Batubara in Medan showed negative attitudes towards Batubara malay language . There were 12 respondents (60 %) of university students showed negative attitudes and 8 respondents (40%) university students showed positive attitudes.

2. Based on the levels of language attitudes in the levels receiving , responding, internalizing values the university students have negative attitudes towards Batubara Malay language while in the levels valuing the attitude is balanced between negative and positive attitudes and in the level organizing the university students of Batubara in Medan have positive attitudes.

3. There are three factors that underline the language attitude of the university students of Batubara in Medan towards Batubara Malay language namely, language disloyalty, language pride lack and language unawareness of the norm. From those factors the university students fullfil the three characteristics of language disloyalty, language pride lack and language unawareness of the norm because they did not maintain their language.

5.2 Suggestions

In relation to the conclusion, the following are suggested:

1. It is suggested to the university students of Batubara to maintain Batuabara Malay language whenever they stay and do not be shy to use Batubara malay language especially with their friend who came from Batubara.
2. It is suggested to all university students of Batubara in Medan to take active follow the Organization of Batubara (PB KEMBAR SUMUT) so that we can always use Batubara Malay language especially with Batubara people. And also to local goverment of Batubara to pay attantion about Batubara malay language and make some regulation to society of Baubara to use Batubara malay language whenever they stay.
3. It is also suggested to language researcher to do futher research about language attitudes.
