

CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, conclusion can be drawn as follows:

1. The five types of illocutionary Acts are found in Naruto Shippuden Movie 3 "Inherited the Will of Fire". They are (1) Representative that it is intended for asserting, claiming, statement, hypothesis, conveys, concluding, affirming reporting, believing, denying, and describing, (2) Directive that it is intended for requesting, commanding, warning, permitting, urging questioning, ordering, suggesting, advising, begging, challenging, insisting, and pleading, (3) Commisive that it is intended for promising, threatening, swearing and offering, (4) Expressives that it is intended for thanking, apologizing, welcoming, joy, like, dislike, complaining, deploring, condoling, sorrow, and congratulating, and (5) Declarative that it is intended for declaring war, firing, marrying, bidding, etc. The total number of those five types illocutionary acts are 1009 utterances. The total number of Representative is 375 (57,16%) utterances. The total number of Directive is 467 (46,28%) utterances. The total number of Commisive is 56 (5,55%) utterances. The total number Expressive is 99 (9,81%) utterances and the total number of Declarative is 12 (1,18%) utterances.

2. The data findings shown that Directive type is dominantly used in this movie. The Representative type is used when the character gives the statement, the Commissive type is used when the character gives the promise or something that will effect in the future, Expression type is used when the character expresses a state of joy, welcoming dislike, Declarative type is used when the character declare the wars, marrying, biding, firing, etc.
3. The most dominant type of illocutionary acts used in Naruto Shippuden Movie 3 "Inherited the Will of Fire" is Directive (46,28%). This implies that the Directive plays a great role in the novel. It means that It means that requesting, commanding, warning, permitting, urging questioning, ordering, suggesting, advising, begging, challenging, insisting, and pleading is almost always seen in this movie.

B. Suggestion

The followings are written as the suggestion related with the conclusions above:

1. The teacher, it is better for them to understand not only the theory of illocutionary acts but also the application of that theory such found in Naruto Shippuden Movie 3 "Inherited the Will of Fire".
2. The readers, it is well suggested to watch Naruto Shippuden Movie 3 "Inherited the Will Of Fire", because it's nice to watch, has so many moral lesson that will teach the readers. This movie is an animation but do

not see the cartoon as the character but see the value that is bury in this movie. This movie is also contain of those five illocutionary acts.

3. The students to make other research relate to pragmatics especially the illocutionary acts in order to enlarge knowledge. They can do the investigations in other subjects such as news, speeches, songs, advertisements, interviews, and so on.
