## **5.1.** Conclusions

After doing the research, the writer concluded as the followings: Jane Austen active in her writing in the twentyth century. There are some situation of culture of England that influenced her works

## 1. Politic

There are the social class differentiation for women in Britain 1800s. The divisions of the classes were very distinct, and although none of the women in any of the classes had much power, there were differences in the daily life, family life and working life. This situation are showed in Austen's Work. Lady chaterine as an aunt of Darcy intervened their relationship. She look down Elizabeth Bennet and announced that Darcy is a rich man got a good education is suitable engaged to her daughter .
