## CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

## A. Conclusions

After analyzing the data and determining the types of speech acts in the transcripts of Toba wedding ceremony, some conclusions were presented as the following:

- Four types of speech acts from five types of speech acts were occurred in Toba wedding ceremony. They were directives (23), commisives (2), representatives (1), and declaratives (6).
- 2. The most dominant type of speech acts in umpasa Toba wedding ceremony was directives with 23 utterances (71,87%).
- The reasons of the dominant type of speech acts appeared because umpasa inToba wedding ceremony mostly used for giving moral message or advice.



## **B.** Suggestions

By considering the research findings and conclusions, there are some suggestions which are presented as the following:

- 1. Studentsare suggested how to use or utter the speech acts in the situational context of communication.
- 2. People are suggestedlearn how to use or utter the speech acts in are used.
- 3. Other researchers this research usefull for a guidance or reference for the further research about analysis of speech acts.
