Economic growth can be the best progress in an area when the use of financial conducted effectively and increase regional financial independence. The research results show that regency of West Pasaman having the ratio the effectiveness of revenue of regional 98,90 % are classified as effective , but the result regression shows that the ratio the effectiveness of local revenue not yet made significant impact on regional economic growth. While to the ratio of financial independence a region just 6,52 % and classified in the very weak as well as the results regression also shows that the ratio financial independence not yet made significant impact on regional economic growth.
