

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter discusses about conclusions and suggestions on the basis of the result of research and discussion presented in the previous chapter.

A. CONCLUSIONS

Developing audio-visual media for writing descriptive text at SMA Mardi Lestari follow Research and Development (R&D) model by Dirgeyasa (2011). There are several steps of R&D, they are: (1) Evaluation, (2) Need Analysis, (3) Validation. The product of developing audio-visual media for teaching descriptive text is validated by two experts. The average score is 92.72%, which means the average score of the product is in *Very Good* criteria. With the result, it concluded that audio-visual media is very good and appropriate to use for teaching descriptive text for tenth grade students at SMA Mardi Lestari

B. SUGGESTIONS

Based on the conclusions above, Researcher gives three suggestions. They are:

1. For the teachers, the benefit of using media in teaching would help the teacher in varying teaching and learning activities in the classroom. Audio-visual media attracts students' interest and provide opportunity to practice writing descriptive text.
2. The students, by implementing teaching media teacher could help the students to improve their ability in writing their interest.

3. For other researcher, it is suggested that other researcher to conduct further studies in developing audio-visual media for another lesson which is relevant to students' need in order to increase students' comprehension in learning. In developing media other researcher can use Powtoon as software to develop the media.



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
