

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, some conclusions were drawn as the following.

1. The types of Transitivity; process, participant, and circumstance are shown in every *onang – onang* of Batak Angkola. Process as the core of analyzing mostly construed mental and Relational Process because the utterances contained love, affections, and compliment and from the analysis of processes, the researcher found that *Batak angkola* people are emotional human being because they like to remind their family of their love and memories. Participant related to process. Senser was found as the most using participant in the analysis because the researcher found that the love and compliment that given among the family were accepted by everyone, so they could feel everything for real, the participant used their sense of feeling to remember their history, for that Senser mostly used in *onang-onang* utterances. Circumstance was found in these utterances because by the end of the clauses, often given information. The repeating word of ‘stage’ often found which made circumstance of location dominated in all utterances. The researcher found that the use of circumstance was important in *angkolanese* clause orally in order to emphasize their language formally or informally.
2. The congruent realization is shown in all types. The use of incongruent in Batak Angkola language was known as their identity. They tend to use proverb or metaphorical language to express their thought and feelings, especially the researcher discovered their proverb in songs and traditional

events. The researcher acknowledged that some of the utterances in *onang – onang* used metaphorical clauses. The chief tribal also considered that their great great culture tend to express their language in form of beautiful proverb. By this Fact, the researcher can immediately find the incongruent form of expression in several parts of the clauses. But including of all utterances, verbal and existential process have shown empty data for incongruent realization.

B. Suggestion

In relation to conclusion, suggestions were staged as the following

1. It is suggested to the other researcher to do more research about transitivity system in *Batak Angkola society*
2. It is suggested to the lecturers who play an important role in teaching functional grammar to give attention in analyzing transitivity system in cultural language.
3. It is suggested to do more introductions regarding to traditional languages among young generation especially students. As the fact that most of the neighborhood have chosen their first language into Bahasa Indonesia and the global language has become trend world wide all the way to the countryside which made less interest among the young people to know their own ethnic.

Indonesia is rich by social culture and languages. While Batak Angkola is one of the precious societies that have massive and rich culture that need to be preserved. It is needed more research about this language in many aspects, and the lecturers must give the right concern to guide their students to do the research.
