ABSTRACT

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The objective of this study is to find out the type of code-mixing used by the teacher and students and the factors causing the teacher and students mix the language in classroom interaction. Code-mixing is a bilingualism phenomenon which have become very popular in society. It is used to prevent misunderstanding such the teacher and students in classroom interaction.
