

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusions

After analysing the data of figure of speech on political headline in newspaper, the conclusions and suggestions were made below;

1. There were 7 out of 12 types of figures of speech were found in political headline of Waspada and Sinar Indonesia Baru newspaper. The figures of speech covered symbol, hyperbole, irony, apostrophe, synecdoche, paradox and personification. The most dominant figures of speech in Waspada and Sinar Indonesia Baru were symbol. It can be found in the two newspapers.
2. Based on the data analysis on the both newspapers there are three of four functions of figure of speech which are found in Waspada and SIB headline political, i.e., to add emotional intensity, to say much in a brief compass and to give imaginative pleasure. Hyperbole, personification function in both adding emotional intensity to the readers and saying much in a brief compass. Apostrophe and irony only function in adding emotional intensity to the readers. Synecdoche and paradox only function in saying much in a brief compass. Symbol only function in affording imaginative pleasure to the readers. Based on analysis, researcher found that one as the new finding that is to give the reader criticism to messages the one in the headline particularly political headline.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusion stated above, this study has some suggestions to the readers as provided in the following terms;

1. It is suggested that further studies should be conducted to find out more types of figures of speech in other context.
2. To the other researchers, it is suggested that this study could be further expanded, elaborated and explored in other field in order to contribute the development of figures of speech, such as the figures of speech used in other application or literary works.
3. To the lectures which study in the same field, it is highly suggested to conduct, elaborate and perform deep research in the study and also can be a reference or comparison for the further similar research and phenomenon.
