CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

Based on the data analysis that presented in the previous chapter, some concludes can be stated as follows;

- 1. Taboo language can still be found in the traditional market. Then, from 20 taboo words by 20 dialogues script between sellers and buyers at Pajak Sore Padang Bulan Medan, the dominant types is Insult and Slur 35% followed by Scatology 25%, Epithet 15% Cursing 5%, Profanity 5%, Blasphemy 5%, Obscenity 5%, Vulgarity 5%.
- 2. There were also impacts of taboo language from some Batak sellers that who often use taboo language towards their customers through the research were first, some of Batak sellers become the aggressive people. It means that person will be more aggressive when other people offend him, second person can be hated by others and third sometimes they can cause pain to others because they become the people who have the irrational thinking. It means that when someone feel angered and hated with others, they can say taboo words to vent their anger but sometimes they also become people who do not have rational thinking, they do not have rational thinking means that they can do whatever they want without thinking firstly.

3. Then, some perceptions and knowledge about their taboo language such as Batak people at Pajak Sore Padang Bulan Medan feel dislike about their taboo language, because they thought that the language is a bad language, the language can make someone who says it will be hated and despised by people, it was not the language that can be spoken in public places or anywhere and the language can affect children under the age, because when listening to the language, because children would replicate and pronounce the taboo language.

B. Suggestions

Based on the conclusion above, some suggestions can be stated as follows;

- 1. For English Department student, in order to understand the types and the impacts of taboo words, especially the types of taboo words in Batak Toba language, the first thing is to pay a better attention in categorizing the types and the impacts of taboo words because not all taboo words can be only categorized as one of each types. They could be cross categorized depend on the context of the sentences.
- 2. To the readers who are concerned to this study, to continue and get more details about analysis of taboo words used by Batak sellers and Batak customers at Pajak Sore Padang Bulan Medan.
- 3. For others researchers who want to explore more about this study, to conduct the research about taboo words and make the depth analysis in other objects.
