## **CHAPTER V**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## A. Conclusion

Based on the analysis, there are some important points are conclude, as the following:

- 1. The types of code mixing that was found in this study were insertion, alternation, and congruent lexicalization. The speakers use the word from third languages that are inserted randomly.
- 2. The dominant function of the code mixing of sipituhuta language in Merek wedding ceremony is expressing group identity. The other functions are talking about particular topic, repitition for clarification, being emphatic about something, intention of clarifiying the speech content for interloculator, and quoting somebody else, but there is not found interjection function in this research.
- 3. The ceremony consists of two ethnic ,it were Toba and Simalungun ethnic, so depends with that factor we can concluded that the social community, multilingualism, situation, vocabulary and speaker and partner speaking as the reasons why the speaker used code mixing in that ceremony.

## **B.** Suggestion

In line with the conclusions, suggestions are staged as the following:

- 1. It is a suggest for the people in Merek can save their local language as their characteristic that mixed some language in communication.
- 2. The researcher hope that this thesis can be useful for everyone who study of sociolinguistic and can be a source of knowledge about code mixing especially in local language for the readers.
