CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION

After the researcher analyzed and interprets the data from the previous chapter, this chapter gave the research's conclusion and suggestions for further research. The conclusion is derived from the explanation of the research problem, meanwhile the suggestion is designed to provide information to future researchers who wanted to conduct similar study.

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, it can be concluded that:

- After analyzing the Hamilton Lyrics, it was found there were three mood types used by the author, they are ; 1) Declarative Mood, 2) Imperative Mood, 3) Interrogative Mood. From the total of 171 clauses, it is found that 136 of them are declarative mood, 27 of them are imperative mood, and 8 of them are interrogative mood. It shows that the dominant mood used is declarative mood.
- 2. The researcher has analyzed and classified the Hamilton Lyrics based on the order of subject and finite to find the mood types and modality in each clause. The interpersonal function analysis was described and provided the examples of how that sentence categorized into the specific mood types and residue. If the order of the element is subject followed by finite, then it is classified as the declarative mood, and the interrogative mood is realized

through the order of finite followed by subject. Meanwhile for the imperative mood, the order of the element does not always consist of subject and finite, they may consist of subject only, finite only, or no mood element.

B. Suggestion

From the research result that have been concluded by the researcher, the researcher would like to suggest some points:

1. The Readers

The researcher wish that this study can help the readers, especially English Literature Students in understanding the concept of Interpersonal Function in Hamilton Lyrics.

2. The future researchers

The researcher suggests for the future researchers to continue the research, because this research has the weakness that is the lack of theory that is used to analyze the problems of research since the researcher used theory by Halliday. And also the results of analysis are also limited. It is recommended for the future researchers especially who are interested in the same topic to try to use more than one theory to cover the results.

The researcher also suggest for the next researcher to do a research based on gender, it would be more challenging to categorize the types of interpersonal function so for the furture researchers can use another theory based on gender category.
