

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the result of the research and discussion that has been described, it can be concluded that:

1. The level of self-efficacy of biology education study program students grade of 2017 who were working on their thesis during the Covid-19 pandemic at Universitas Negeri Medan was classified as a medium level.
2. The thesis working duration of biology education study program students class of 2017 during the Covid-19 pandemic at Universitas Negeri Medan was classified into the medium category with an average thesis work duration of 17.5 months.
3. The correlation between Self-efficacy and Thesis Working Duration on 2017 Biology Education study program students during the Covid-19 pandemic at Universitas Negeri Medan was categorized into strong correlation with an r_{xy} value of 0.686.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions above, suggestions that can be submitted are as follows:

1. Students who are working on or will be working on a thesis are expected to be able to increase self-efficacy in order to achieve the desired goals and overcome obstacles that will be encountered.
2. This research is expected to be a source or reference for further relevant research for future researcher.
