The aimed of this research is to explain how teachers use the RAFT Strategy to teaching descriptive text writing to tenth-grade students. By being actively involved, students can learn and follow the lesson effectively. It also makes it easier for them to identify the objects they want to describe, build a strong understanding of social functions, generic structures, and language features, and develop critical thinking abilities. The research aimed to determine the extent to which students apply their abilities effectively in writing descriptive texts.
