

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

After analyzing the hate speech that occur in the tweets of Harry Maguire's Twitter Account as the data on the previous chapter, the researcher discovered the following conclusions:

- 1) There were five types of hate speech used in the tweets of Harry Maguire's Twitter Account, namely Behavior, Physical, Class, Ethnicity, and Sex Orientation. The most frequently used was behavior.
