

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is divided into two sections. There are conclusion and suggestion. In conclusion section, it presents the conclusion of the research by summarizing the previous chapter of finding, discussion and data analysis. Then in suggestion section, there will be presented some suggestions concerning to this study.

5.1. Conclusion

This study is expected to discover the answer to the research questions which are about teachers' strategies in teaching English to deaf students and the challenge faced by the teacher during the teaching and learning process. Based on the data analysis, the conclusion is presented as follows:

- A. There were three strategies the teacher used in teaching deaf students namely: (1) learning about vocabulary because the teacher tended to focus on teaching the deaf students to master vocabulary, (2) teaching with simple words and sentences due to the students' limitation in doing spoken conversation, (3) using diverse teaching media such as textbook, pictures, and textbook.
- B. There were four challenges that the teacher faced during the teaching and learning process, namely: (1) most of the students had short memory so the teacher had to do a lot of repetition on each meeting, (2) most of the students were born-deaf so that the students had less ability in mastering

words because of students' issue in processing and producing language. For instance, the challenges that teachers faced during teaching and learning process came from the students. (3) the differences in students' hearing ability, students' IQ, and also students' background knowledge that was causing the teacher to allocate more time to spread out the understanding of English material taught by the teacher to each student, and (4) the students often got angry or bored easily when they were no longer interested in the learning process, but the teacher would always try to make a good learning environment so that the students could feel comfortable and enjoy the learning process.

5.2. Suggestion

Suggestion Based on the conclusion above, the researcher would like to mention some suggestions which are presented as follows:

- A. For the teacher Teaching English to deaf students is not easy. In spite of the fact that most of the students are born deaf, they must have issues in processing and producing language even if it is Bahasa Indonesia. There are some challenges that teachers faced during the teaching and learning process. The teacher does have a way to deal with the challenge. on the other hand, the teacher still needs to consider the combination of the strategies which have been explained in the findings to cut off the time constraint and make the English teaching and learning process more effective and efficient.

B. For further research Hopefully, future researchers would analyze this issue deeper. This research is also expected to be continued by another researcher with another focus that has not been covered in this research. Furthermore, further research is needed to explain the better combination of the strategies above to make the learning process more effective and make the English teaching and learning process more meaningful.
