

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui persepsi remaja mengenai konten lesbian, gay, biseksual, dan transgender (LGBT) pada aplikasi TikTok di Desa Sikapas Kecamatan Muara Batang Gadis Kabupaten Mandailing Natal. Populasi penelitian ini seluruh remaja yang berusia 13-19 tahun yang berjumlah sebanyak 172 orang. Sampel penelitian berjumlah sebanyak 44 orang yang diambil dengan acak. Pengumpulan data melalui angket. Data dianalisis secara deskriptif persentase. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa remaja memiliki persepsi yang berbeda-beda, ada yang berpersepsi secara positif dan ada yang berpersepsi secara negatif. Persepsi diukur melalui 3 unsur yaitu: unsur kognisi, unsur afeksi, dan unsur konasi. Dari unsur kognisi (pengetahuan remaja mengenai eksistensi LGBT pada aplikasi tiktok) diperoleh hasil jawaban Sangat Setuju 18,7%, Setuju 38,4%, Tidak Setuju 26,4%, dan Sangat Tidak Setuju 16,6%. Pengetahuan dan pemahaman remaja mengenai eksistensi LGBT pada aplikasi TikTok, pencapaian dominan memilih jawaban setuju sebanyak 38,4%. Unsur afeksi (tanggapan remaja terhadap kegiatan sehari-hari kelompok LGBT baik secara individu ataupun dengan pasangannya guna meningkatkan eksistensinya di aplikasi TikTok) diperoleh hasil jawaban Sangat Setuju 15,2%, Setuju 38,6%, Tidak Setuju 27,7%, dan Sangat Tidak Setuju 18,6%. Pengetahuan dan pemahaman remaja mengenai eksistensi LGBT pada aplikasi TikTok, pencapaian dominan memilih jawaban Setuju sebanyak 38,6%. dan Unsur konasi (penilaian remaja terhadap perkembangan eksistensi kelompok LGBT yang semakin meningkat di aplikasi TikTok) diperoleh hasil jawaban Sangat Setuju 17,7%, Setuju 33,6%, Tidak Setuju 29,5%, dan Sangat Tidak Setuju 19%. Pengetahuan dan pemahaman remaja mengenai eksistensi LGBT pada aplikasi TikTok, pencapaian dominan memilih jawaban Setuju sebanyak 33,6%.

ABSTRACT

This research aims to determine teenagers' perceptions regarding lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) content on the TikTok application in Panggangas Village, Muara Batang Girls District, Mandailing Natal Regency. The population of this study were all teenagers aged 13-19 years, totaling 172 people. The research sample consisted of 44 people taken randomly. Data collection through questionnaires. Data were analyzed descriptively as percentages. The results of the research show that teenagers have different perceptions, some perceive it positively and some perceive it negatively. Perception is measured through 3 elements, namely: cognition elements, affection elements, and conation elements. From the cognition element (adolescents' knowledge about the existence of LGBT in the tikotk application), the answers obtained were 18.7% Strongly Agree, 38.4% Agree, 26.4% Disagree, and 16.6% Strongly Disagree. Teenagers' knowledge and understanding regarding the existence of LGBT on the TikTok application, the dominant achievement was choosing the agree answer as much as 38.4%. The affection element (adolescents' responses to the daily activities of LGBT groups either individually or with their partners in order to increase their existence on the TikTok application) obtained answers of 15.2% Strongly Agree, 38.6% Agree, 27.7% Disagree, and Strongly Disagree 18.6%. Teenagers' knowledge and understanding regarding the existence of LGBT on the TikTok application, the dominant achievement was choosing the Agree answer as much as 38.6%. and the element of conation (adolescents' assessment of the development of the existence of LGBT groups which is increasing in the TikTok application) obtained answers of 17.7% Strongly Agree, 33.6% Agree, 29.5% Disagree, and 19% Strongly Disagree. Teenagers' knowledge and understanding regarding the existence of LGBT on the TikTok application, the dominant achievement was choosing the Agree answer as much as 33.6%.
