CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusions

This study relates to the speech acts used in the Jay Shetty Podcast. This aims to describe the speech used in Jay Shetty's three postcast videos with his three guest stars, namely Kendall Jenner, Trevor Noah and Jerrod Carmichael. Based on the analysis, the conclusion is.

- In Jay Shetty's podcast with the three guest stars, namely Kendall Jenner, Trevor Noah, and Jerrod Carmichael, it was found that direct speech acts were used, namely declarative (31 utterances), exploratory (32 utterances), and representative (12 utterances). However, in this podcast, the type of Directive speech act does not play a role in the podcast conversation.
- 2. The speech acts in Jay Shetty's podcast are well realized in producing varied communication, informative, inspiring, and of course interactive content. This shows that the podcast produces quality and in-depth conversations on the digital media of the YouTube Podcast platform.

B. Suggestion

For parties who are interested in the interactions that occur in communication activities, it is recommended to study the types of speech acts.

 It is recommended that the person communicating between the speaker and listener be able to understand the words conveyed by the speaker. This is to help both of them understand what actions and responses must be conveyed correctly so that there are no misunderstandings between them.

- 2. It is also recommended that lecturers who play an important role in teaching pragmatics and sociolinguistics provide attention in teaching speech acts.
- 3. It is recommended that all of us as writers and readers of this thesis be able to understand the types of speech acts. The use of what types of speech acts can help clarify the communication that is being built well.
