

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

After the data of anxiety and the defense mechanism strategy used in main character Beatrice Prior's Divergent Novel had been analyzed, conclusion were described as follow:

1. There were 2 from 3 types of anxiety experienced by Beatrice prior character in Divergent novel. Among them moral and realistic anxiety was the most often appears in the specific dialogues contained in the specific dialogues of the main character Beatrice Prior. B. Suggestions
