A.Conclusion

The ability of satire to highlight and criticize shortcomings and absurdity is the link between the satirical approach and reflection on life. Irony, paradox, antithesis, exaggeration, anticlimax, enlargement, and parody are satirical techniques used to mock or criticize a particular topic. With the use of this technique, satire encourages critical thinking about various aspects of life and reconsider behavior in their own lives.
