CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

After analyzing the data of the research, the researcher draws some conclusion as the following:

- 1. From the six types of process that concluded by Halliday, It was found that all types of process were found in the texts. They are material process, mental process, relational process, behavioral process, verbal process and existential process.
- 2. The most dominant process that found in the text is material process. There are 868 verbs from 1387 verbs as material process (62.58 %). It can be concluded that the material process, a process of doing, is the most dominant used if counting totally from selected speeches of President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono. Material processes are processes of 'doing'. They express the notion that some entity 'does' something-which may be done 'to' some other entity. Semantically material processes indicates activities or events, which happen outside the human beings. This process refers to physical experience of human beings. Those speeches were dominated with material process which mean that the speeches need physical activities in realization not just as verbal activities.

B. Suggestions

Based on the conclusion given, the following suggestions are needed to be considered in conducting the related research:

- 1. The writer suggests the students and the lecturers who study about functional grammar to use the theory of transitivity in observing and revealing the phenomena in the world.
- 2. It is suggested for those students of English Department to give more understanding about the using of process in speech. It can be analyzed by process that he use to compare between the text and the realization of the speech in this country.
