

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, it was found that the students' writing score improved from cycle I until cycle II. It is shown from the improvement of the students' score. It can be proved by recognizing the improvement of the mean of the students' achievement in writing descriptive paragraph test score; in the pre-test the mean score was 61.4. In the first cycle, the mean score was 70.6, and then in the second cycle the mean score was 77.93. The students' score improved continuously in each writing test. From the improvement, it can be concluded that the five-sense technique can improve the students' achievement in writing descriptive paragraph.

B. Suggestions

This study shows that the five-sense technique improves the students' achievement in writing descriptive paragraph. Due to the conclusion above, there are some points suggested as follows:

- a. For the teachers, especially in teaching writing. The teacher can use the five-sense technique as another technique writing descriptive paragraph.

It helps the teacher to attract the students' attention to describe the object.

- b. For the students. The five-sense technique can stimulate the students to increase their writing achievement. The students are more active when they are taught by applying the five-sense technique.
