

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

Based on the result of the study, the conclusions are drawn as follows:

- There is an improvement of students' achievement in reading descriptive text if it is taught by using Cooperative Script Method. It is showed from the mean of the students' scores in three test: test I (56.44), Test II in cycle I (69.89), and test III in cycle II (81.58). It means that the use of Cooperative Script Method could improve the students' achievement in reading descriptive text.

- The observation sheet, interview sheet and diary notes indicated that there is improvement in students' abilities. It is shown that most of students became more active and more active working in pairs and it is strengthened by the improvement of their reading scores.

- It is proved quantitatively and qualitatively that the application of Cooperative Script Method improves the students' reading comprehension achievement in descriptive text.

B. Suggestion

Based on the result of this study, the use of the Cooperative Script Method could improve the students' achievement in reading descriptive text. The following suggestions are offered:

1. The students to improve their reading comprehension achievement by applying Cooperative Script Method especially descriptive text.
2. The teacher to use Cooperative Script Method so that they can improve their students' achievement in reading comprehension.
3. To all the readers, may this research bring them into good understanding how to improve the students' reading comprehension through Cooperative Script Method.



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
