CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

The mean of control and experimental group in the post-test score are 63,4 and 69,27. The number of the students for each group is 30. It means that the mean score of experimental group is higher than those of control group.

The result of calculation of t-test shows that the value of t-obsreve (3,3) is higher than value of the t-table (2,00). It means that the null hpothesis (Ho) is rejected and the alternative hypothesis is accepted. The hypothesis stating that the partners tecnique significantly affects the students' narrative writing is accepted.

The students who are taught by using partner tecnique get better score than those who are taught by using individual.

B. Suggestion

As the result of the study, is is suggested that :

- 1. The English teachers apply partners tecnique in improving students' ability in writing a narrative paragraph by giving much exercise to the students.
- 2. The students should apply partners tecnique in writing a narrative paragraph by practicing

it over and over again.

3. The researcher should use partner tecnique in English writing to enable learners write a

good narrative paragraph.
