## CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

## A. Conclusions

Based on the data analysis on the previous chapter, there are some points of the result that can be drawn:

- 1. The writer found that Nathaniel Hawthorne Scarlet Letter Novel is the novel with much symbolism. To show humanity's attitude and the hidden value of the symbol, this is worth knowing because it concerns with the social life.
- 2. There are five kinds of symbols in Nathaniel Hawthorne Scarlet Letter Novel that is place, nature, color, character, and he symbol of the letter "A".
