CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

After analyzing the using of language functions in *Sherlock Holmes II: A Game of Shadows* movie, the conclusions can be drawn as follows:

- 1. There are six types of language function used in *Sherlock Holmes II: A Game of Shadows* movie which are expressive, directive, referential, metalinguistic, phatic, and poetic.
- 2. The dominant type of language function used in *Sherlock Holmes II: A Game of Shadows* movie is metalinguistic function with the 65 occurrences (38%).
- 3. Metalinguistic function is the dominant type of language function used in *Sherlock Holmes II: A Game of Shadows* movie. It has an implication that Sherlock Holmes used that function mostly in his utterances because as a detective, he established the agreement and conveyed the codes by asking questions to the people in order to dig, find out, and connect information so that he might invent clue for the sake of his investigation.

B. Suggestions

Related to the conclusions, it is well to suggest:

1. For the readers, it is better to understand the language function that is used by Sherlock Holmes as the main character in *Sherlock Holmes II: A Game of Shadows* movie, so they will know the purposes or function of his utterances. For other researches, this thesis can be used as reference when they decide to discuss the same topic for their thesis.
