

CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

After analyzing the data and determining the types of speech acts in the transcripts of Toba wedding ceremony, some conclusions were presented as the following:

1. Four types of speech acts from five types of speech acts were occurred in Toba wedding ceremony. They were directives (23), commissives (2), representatives (1), and declaratives (6).
2. The most dominant type of speech acts in umpasa Toba wedding ceremony was directives with 23 utterances (71,87%).
3. The reasons of the dominant type of speech acts appeared because umpasa in Toba wedding ceremony mostly used for giving moral message or advice.

B. Suggestions

By considering the research findings and conclusions, there are some suggestions which are presented as the following:

1. Students are suggested how to use or utter the speech acts in the situational context of communication.
2. People are suggested learn how to use or utter the speech acts in are used.
3. Other researchers this research useful for a guidance or reference for the further research about analysis of speech acts.
