This study is concerned with developing learning materials for teaching descriptive text. This study was conducted by using Research and Development (R&D) design through six phases was gathering information and data, analyzing data, designing materials, validating new materials by experts, revising materials based on expert' suggestion and revised developing materials (final product). The subject of this research was students in grade IX in Prasan Wittaya Mulnithi School. Instrument for collecting data were questionnaire and interview. After analyzing the data, the researcher got the students' need in learning English in descriptive text.
