CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

Based on the research findings found after analyzing the data, it can be concluded that :

- 1. Toba Batak sellers and buyers violated the maxims in their daily conversation in Parluasan traditional market Pematangsiantar. They violated all types of maxim with the total number was 117. There were 58 utterances which violated the maxim of quantity, 12 utterances which violated the maxim of quality, 20 utterances which violated the maxim of relation, and 27 utterances which violated the maxim of manner.
- 2. Toba Batak sellers and buyers had their own implications in violating the maxims. They were: to show respect, to create hyperbole and irony, to change a topic, to keep a secret, and to create humors.

B. Suggestions

Having conducted a research about violating maxims, it is useful to consider the following suggestions:

1. For everyone when they are involved in a conversation, to understand and obey the maxims by giving informative, true, relevant, and clear information so that there will be misunderstanding or different perception between the speaker and the listener. As well to the readers to enlarge the knowledge of cooperative principle.

2. For English Department students and others who are going to do future research about pragmatics, especially on Cooperative Principle and violating maxims.
