

## **CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS**

### **A. Conclusion**

The existing writing materials were not interesting and made the students confused during the learning writing process. The students need the writing materials design based on Problem-Based Learning. It can help students become more active and enthusiasm to increase their writing skill.

New writing materials were designed by using research and development design proposed by Borg & Gall (2003:571). It was designed through problem-based learning approach. Problem-based learning is provided by group activity. So, the students are more active and enjoyable in learning English. In order to ease the students' grammar, the materials are provided the information about grammar used in learning writing by giving kinds of activity related to the grammar. By giving step by step, the students can enjoyable in learning writing process and can increase their writing skill better. In the end of the learning process, hopefully, the students can write their experience in their real life by their own words at least 150 words individually.

### **B. Suggestions**

The final product of this research is writing materials based on problem-based learning for students of eighth grade at SMP Negeri 27 Medan. Considering the materials development, there are some suggestions proposed for some parties.

### 1. The English Teacher

The English teacher of eighth grade students in junior high school who teach English could use the developed materials in the teaching and learning process as a supplementary in learning writing recount text. These developed materials accomplish to increase the ability of the students in writing skill, especially in writing recount text.

### 2. The other Materials Developers

It is suggested that the development materials should consider and concern to the students' needs and relate the materials to the students' real life. The next thing that should be considered by the developers is the design of the materials. The design of the materials should be interesting for the students.
