CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusion

After analyzing the data, it was found that the scores of the student in control group of pre-test was 1468, the mean score 48.93 and the post-test was 1988, the mean score 66.26. Moreover, the total score in experimental group of pre-test was 1476, the mean score 49.06 and the post-test was 2244, the mean score 74.8. It was concluded that the using of comic strips significantly affects the students on reading comprehension in narrative text and it showed that the student scores in experimental group are higher than in control group. Since the t-observed (5.87) is higher than t-table (2.00) for the degree of freedom 58 at level of significant $\mu = 0.05$. It means the null hypothesis (Ho) was rejected and alternative hypothesis (Ha) was accepted because there was significant effect of comic strips on Students reading comprehension in narrative text. Besides that, the students' attitude and skill was also significantly improved while being taught by using comic strips.

B. Suggestions

Based on the conclusion drawn, the results of the findings contribute some valuable suggestions, they are:

 The English Teacher are suggestion to use comic strips as a media in their teaching learning process in order to improve their students' achivement in reading narrative text.

- 2. Students are advised to have more practices in reading text to improve their reading comprehension ability, attitude and skill because it can make students more easily to understand the text and students think about what they know and what they want to know, so that they can explore what they have learned by using comic strips.
- 3. For other researcher can develop similar research to help teacher to improve the learning technique specially in reading comprehension.
