This study concern on how reading text are developed for vocational school. This study was conducted by using Research and Development (R & D) design through six phases; gathering information and data, analyzing data, designing new reading materials, validating by experts, revising, and final product. The subject of this research was the students in grade XI of Light Vehicle Technique study program at SMK Swasta Bandung-2 consisting of 20 students. Instrumentations for collecting data were questionnaire and interview. After analyzing the data, the researcher got the students' need in learning English in term of vocation that they have.
