CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

The conclusion of this research is drawn based on the data analysis, findings, and conclusion as the following:

- 1. All types of process occurred in the clauses of female presenters; material, mental, relational, verbal, behavioral, and existential. Meanwhile, there were five types of process found in the clauses of male presenter; material process, mental process, relational process, behavioral process, and verbal process. And there were four types of circumstance found in the clauses of male and female presenters; location, extent, cause, and manner.
- 2. The transitivity realization of ideational metaphor covers almost all types of process, including material, mental, relational, verbal, behavioral and existential process. The congruent realization happened due to of the use of human or animate being that can do something physically. The incongruent realization happened due to of the use of inanimate participant by which actor doesn't have capacity of human like that can do something physically, experience something, describe and say something.
- 3. The reason why the experiential function elements realized in the ways they are, based on the analysis of process; material, mental, relational, behavioral, verbal, and existential; participants; actor, goal, sense, phenomenon, carrier, attributive, sayer, verbiage, behaver, existent that

determined by process, and circumstance; extent, location, manner and cause.

5.2 Suggestions

- 1. It is suggested to other researchers to find the new findings related to systemic functional linguistics and metafunction.
- 2. It is suggested to Pusat Bahasa and Kemendikbud to develop teachers and lectures' competency to apply and to teach systemic functional linguistic early.
- 3. It is suggested both of English teachers and lectures to teach new grammar system like systemic functional linguistics beside the traditional grammar, so it can be avoid confusedness' for the English learners in the future.
