

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### 5.1 Conclusions

This study essentially focused on the language impoliteness used by governor candidates of DKI Jakarta in election debate 2017. It was intended to describe the types of impoliteness strategies, to explain the realization of impoliteness, and to expose the reason why impoliteness used by the candidate governor in election debate. After analyzing the data, conclusions are drawn as the following.

- (1) There were three types of impoliteness strategies used by candidate governor of DKI Jakarta, namely 1) bald on record impoliteness, 2) positive impoliteness, 3) negative impoliteness. Positive impoliteness was the dominant strategies used by candidate governor .
- (2) In realizations of impolite utterances, there are many ways based on each strategy. Bald on Record has 3 realizations, Positive Impoliteness has 7 realizations, Negative Impoliteness has 3 realizations. In this way, the researchers found 3 strategies used in the data and not all realizations in each strategy used by the candidate governor in the data. The most realizations used in data are make other feel uncomfortable (positive impoliteness) and invade the other's space (negative impoliteness).
- (3) The use of impoliteness used by candidates governor of DKI Jakarta have some reasons. They are (1) to vent negative feeling, (2) to show disagreement, (3) to mock others, (4) to show power, (5) to clarify something.

To show power was the dominant reason used by candidates governor and the least was to show disagreement.

## 5.2 Suggestions

With reference to the conclusions, suggestion are staged as the followings:

- (1) It is suggested that other researcher should be further expanded, elaborated and explored in other field in order to contribute the development of impoliteness theories such as the use of impoliteness in other application or literary works.
- (2) It is suggested that the lecturers teaching sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics, should conduct, elaborate, and perform deep research in the study.
- (3) It is advised that the readers should use the study as references for understanding the application of impoliteness in interactions.
