After analyzed the functions of swearing in Donald Trump's utterances during a presidential debate in 2016, the conclusion was finally formed as followed:

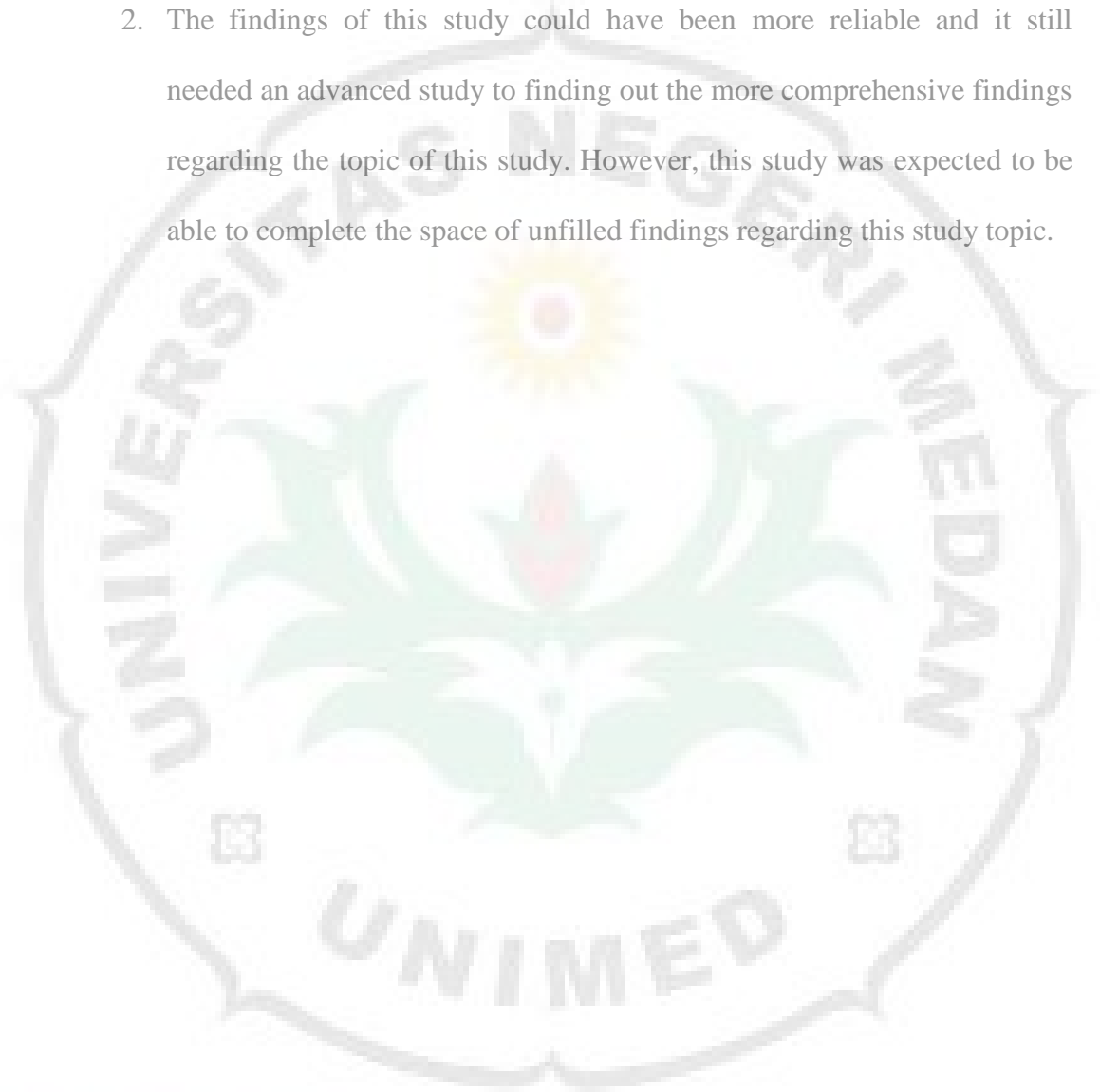
