

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter deals with two parts, namely conclusion and suggestion. The first part presents the conclusions derived from the study. The second part presents suggestions intended for the English teachers, the students, and other researchers.

A. Conclusion

There are two main research questions to answer in this study. The first research question is about the focuses of teacher written feedback on writing procedure text and the second is the teachers' perceptions about their written feedback focuses on writing descriptive text.

Based on the data and data analysis in the previous chapter, the following conclusions were drawn.

1. The focuses of teacher written feedback on students writing procedure text is teacher one and teacher two focus on language form such as vocabulary, grammar, preposition, article and spelling.
2. The two teachers have same perceptions about their written feedback focuses. They think written feedback is a very important practice in writing and perceived as an useful tool, they focus on language form in their written feedback to students' writing, students must have followed grammatical rules to write correctly and expect students to ask and consider the written feedback that they receive.

B. Suggestions

This part presents some suggestions that are expected to be helpful for teachers, students, and other researchers.

- 1) For teachers, the teachers should be able to cover six focuses of teacher written feedback. Focus on language form is important, but the students writing can be better if the teachers also focus on content, text functions ,creative expression, the writing process, and genre in providing written feedback,
- 2) For students, the students should really employ the teachers' written feedback in developing their writings. It can be achieved by having discussion with their teachers after the teachers check their writings.
- 3) For other researchers, other researchers may follow up this study in a longer time in order to find more data so that the result will be more satisfactory.
