CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. Conclusions

After analyzed the data, the conclusions drawn were presented as follows:

- 1. Types of collocation used in the three genre texts (procedure, report, and analytical exposition) contained in the English textbook entitled 'Bahasa Inggris' for grade XI in senior high school were grammatical and lexical collocation. 3 out of 7 sections of grammatical collocations were used in this textbook. Meanwhile, 6 out of 7 lexical collocations were used in this English textbook.
- 2. The used of collocation in each type of texts in this textbook were different. Both grammatical and lexical collocations were balancedly used in procedure text. Meanwhile, the report text and exposition text were mostly used lexical collocation. In the report text, collocation with the combination of 'noun' was the most commonly used, while the other two used collocation with the most used 'verb' combinations. Then, the creative collocation was only used by the report text and its use was also not too prominent.

B. Suggestions

In relation to the conclusions, some suggestions related to this study were presented as follows:

- 1. Theoretically, the findings of this research can later add some new theories and information in learning language as an application of linguistics.
- 2. Practically, this research can be a guidance to the lecturers, college students to comprehend more about the use of collocations in the textbook.
