

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusions

The conclusions from the data analysis and findings in this research were about deception strategies was used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the political debate describe as follows:

1. There were four types of Deception Strategies used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the Political Debate, they were Fabrication, Dissociation/ Depersonalization, Equivocation, and Ostensible Promise.
2. The process of Deception Strategies used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the Political Debate were represented through Violation of the Quality Maxim process and give the result for the Fabrication and Ostensible Promise Strategies. And the Violation of the Manner Maxim process and give the result for the Dissociation and Equivocation strategies.
3. There were three reasons of deception strategies used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the Political Debate, they were Instrumental motives, Identity motives, and Relational motives.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions, the suggestions from the research were about deception strategies was used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the Political Debate stage as follows:

1. For researchers to explain more deeply, and found the different types further research from the object of this study in deception strategies.
2. For students to give more information in the same field by providing more data to analysis the process of deception strategies used by Fahri Hamzah as an Indonesian People's Representative Council in the Political Debate.
3. For the speakers and listeners should learn more to understand the deception strategies and to follow the rules of the process of deception in order to achieve a successful communication and avoid misunderstanding.
