CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 CONCLUSIONS

After analyzing, the data conclusions are drawn as the following.

- 1. There are two types of politeness strategy according to Brown and Levinson (1987), there are: positive politeness and negative politeness in Wedding ceremony of Batak Toba. The dominant type of politeness strategy is Positive Politeness.
- 2. Raja parhata used politeness in wedding ceremony with polite word (Polite utterances), "Use In-group identifies markers" strategy as intimacy relationship with term: Appara, Ito, Lae, Pariban and Dongan Tubu as Intimacy Relationship (Use in group identifies markers).
- 3. Politeness strategies in wedding ceremony of Batak Toba Raja Parhata tend to use positive politeness than negative politeness.

5.2 SUGESSTIONS

In relation to the conclusion above, suggestion are stated as the following.

1. It is essential to conduct other research relating to Politeness strategy, not just on the types of positive politeness and negative politeness, so that it

- will enrich our understanding of Politeness strategy especially in wedding ceremony of batak toba.
- 2. For English Department students who are interested in politeness strategy that they have to know better how to polite strategy (polite utterances) especially in any culture in Indonesia.
- 3. For the next researcher who have the same interest in Politeness strategy, the researcher hopes that the result of this study can make the next researcher who take the same field of research as the reference that might be relevant to their researcher and conduct further studies.
