

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

A. CONCLUSIONS

This study discusses the principle of cooperation in the Hotman Paris Show. After analyzing the data based on the results of this study. The researchers concluded that:

1. There are 4 principles of cooperation adopted by the participants, namely the maxims of quantity, quality, relationship, and method. Specifically, there are 64 maxims of quantity, 29 maxims of quality, 9 maxims of manner, and 8 maxims of relationship.
2. The 8 factors that became the reasons for the participants to violate the cooperative principle were understatement with 20 data, irony 17 data, overstatement 13 data, extreme 10 data, sarcasm 8 data, ambiguous statements 7 data, irrelevant statement 6 data, and metaphors 3 data.

B. SUGGESTIONS

Taking into account the research results and conclusions there are several suggestions put forward as follows:

1. In implicature it does not only discuss conversational implicatures but also has two other types, namely conventional implicatures and politeness implicatures so that they can be taken into consideration for further research to analyze these implicatures.
2. With the factors that result in a violation of the cooperative principle, further researchers can use other theories.
