

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consists of two important points, conclusions, and suggestions related to the analysis that has been carried out in the previous chapter.

#### A. Conclusion

There are several important points in this study. This research aims to find out what types of sarcasm are contained in the Youtube Channel "*Majelis Lucu Indonesia*" video podcast "*Naik jin ke Amerika Cuma 2 jam*" Season 2 - Episode 44. The conclusion of this research can be developed based on the statement study. Researchers have found fifty-eight (58) selected data in the video podcast "*Naik jin ke Amerika Cuma 2 jam*". In this study, two theories are used, including the theory of Elizabeth Camp (2011) to analyze the types of sarcasm, George Yule's theory (1996) to determine utterances to find the meaning and purpose of the speaker's intent in the podcast. The video podcast that the researcher has chosen as a discussion in his research entitled "*Naik jin ke amerika Cuma 2 jam*" Wants to broadcast season 2 - Episode 44, the video is very trending, because the discussion in the podcast contains utterances that contain the four types of sarcasm. Thus, the authors select and capture the utterances of their conversation to be used as research.

The researcher found fifty-eight (58) speaker utterances in the podcast which were adjusted to the types and characteristics of each sarcasm. Which then the utterances are categorized in sarcasm. In this case, all kinds and Utterances are found in every talk of the speaker in the video podcast. Just a few of these less frequently spoken categories of sarcasm that rarely appear on the podcast.

After going through the analysis, the researcher will mention the speaker's utterances in the podcast which belong to the types of sarcasm. The first types of sarcasm, proportional sarcasm, found (21) data utterances, Lexical sarcasm with (23) data utterances, Like-prefixed sarcasm with (5) data utterances, and Illocutionary sarcasm with (9) data.

This is because in this video podcast which consists of two speakers, they give words in the form of an insinuation, admiration for that person, giving praise, insults and saying things that have a negative impact. Behind the words they have mentioned, they want it in the form of praise, and admiration is not entirely true, it's just that they insinuate the person indirectly. in those conversations they say rude things directly by mentioning the name of the person they are discussing. Of all the speaker's utterances in the podcast that have been found to include four types of sarcasm. by saying rude words to "*Berbi Kumalasari that his voice is bad*", these words are included in proportional sarcasm, because these words are an insult to that person. Lexical sarcasm is the types of sarcasm of rejection of what they have said, the types of sarcasm that seems as if they are not the ones who want to

discuss about Berbie Kumalasari in the podcast, saying that they are wrong for discussing this. gave a compliment to Berbi Kumalasari, saying that Berbie Kumalasari should not be bullied but turned into an insult because of the opposite meaning expressed. On the contrary, they had bullied the person. Like-prefixed sarcasm whose words have a specific purpose and meaning for the person, which indicates sarcasm speech to play with language.

### **B. Suggestion**

This research has only focused on four types of sarcasm, namely, Proportional sarcasm, Lexical sarcasm, like-prefixed sarcasm and Illucotinary sarcasm, in conducting the analysis using Pragmatics studies to analyze the speaker's utterances in the video podcast. Not too many aspects can be found that can be analyzed regarding the type of sarcasm with the same theory. Some suggestions for further researchers to analyze in the same field about the types of sarcasm through pragmatic studies on these sayings.

Further research can be analyzed from various intrinsics in it, by conducting research from different perspectives, the researcher's point of view, and using different theories. and future researchers, if interested in continuing this research, can investigate through youtube channels, video podcasts or other literary works, such as those in films, novels using the same conceptual framework or sarcasm and pragmatics theory regarding the same utterances.
