CHAPTER V

CONCLUSSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

After analyzing the data, the conclusion drawn related to the implementation of Google Classroom in teaching reading comprehension of narrative text in MAN 1 Medan as follows:

- 1 The activities of implementing Google Classroom in teaching reading narrative text at eleventh grade in MAN 1 Medan during online learning, teachers follows five stages of e-tivities in classroom are follows: 1) Access and Motivation, 2) Online Socialization, 3) Information exchange, 4) Knowledge construction and 5) Development. In this e-activities activity in online learning, the English teacher at MAN 1 Medan relate all of the activities it to the Google Classroom platform. Google classroom very helpful in the online learning process during the pandemic Covid-19. The implementation of the use of Google Classroom is used for every teaching and learning activity every Monday-Saturday.
